- May be postmarked by 6/18/24 deadline if mailed registered or certified USPS mail. Be prepared to provide a copy of the receipt on 6/18/24.

While **not** part of ballot access, you do need to also ensure you comply with all campaign finance requirements. The Federal Election Commission (FEC) is responsible for federal campaign disclosure laws. Contact the FEC for more information (<https://www.fec.gov/>).
