New Voter ID Requirements – Effective July 1, 2014

~ To vote in the November election, voters must present identification that contains a photograph ~

RICHMOND VA - The new law, effective July 1, 2014, requires voters to present acceptable photo identification to vote in-person for the November election.

Acceptable forms of identification include the following:

- ✓ Valid Virginia Driver's License
- ✓ DMV-issued photo identification card
- ✓ Valid Employee photo identification card
- ✓ Valid United States Passport
- ✓ Government-issued photo identification card
- ✓ Virginia valid college or university student photo identification card
- ✓ New Virginia Voter Photo Identification Card

If you do not have an acceptable form of photo identification, please contact your local voter registration office for a free Virginia Voter Photo Identification Card.

If you do not possess your photo identification when voting, you may still vote a provisional ballot.
