In some parts of the Commonwealth, voters will be required to choose whether to participate in the primary for the Democratic Party or the Republican Party. Voters in Virginia are free to choose in which primary to participate, but are not permitted to participate in both.

Poll Hours: The polls will be open from 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on June 11, 2013. If a voter is in line by 7:00 p.m. he or she will be allowed to vote.

Identification: Identification is required to vote at the polls on June 11, 2013. The identification requirements are the same as those for last year's November General Election. Photo identification is not required to vote; however, certain types of photo identification are acceptable forms of identification that voters may use at the polling place. Changes to the law related to identification requirements to vote will not take effect until July of 2014.
