



Launch of Third Party Voter Registration Training **~Conducted by State Board of Elections and Local Election Officials~**

Effective July 1, 2013, the State Board of Elections (SBE) and local general registrars will be conducting voter registration training mandated by recently enacted legislation (SB1008) that requires individuals or groups obtaining twenty-five (25) or more voter registration applications from SBE or a local voter registration office to register and receive SBE-certified training for conducting voter registration drives.

The training will cover topics including best practices for completion of the voter registration application, maintaining the integrity of the voter registration process, prohibited activities, important deadlines for submission of completed applications, and laws protecting the privacy of applicants. This training will present the opportunity to provide additional information to registration drives that may affect the registration and voting processes, including the restoration of felon voting rights.

SBE will be hosting in-person training at its offices at **1100 Bank St. Richmond, VA 23219**.
