Information we have received from sources such as the U.S. Post Office indicates that you may have moved. State law requires you be registered using your current residential address, but we cannot change your voter registration address without your signature. To ensure you are eligible to vote in future Virginia elections, we must be notified of your correct address.

Please help us update your registration record by visiting elections.virginia.gov/register and updating your record. If you prefer to update your registration record by mail, you may instead complete the following VOTER REGISTRATION ADDRESS VERIFICATION FORM and return it to us. It only takes a moment and will ensure that you are eligible to vote in future Virginia elections.

When we receive your completed form, we will update your record. If you have moved but still reside in Virginia, your local registrar will update your registration and send you a new voter card. If you have moved out of the state, your Virginia voter registration will be cancelled.

If you do not complete the steps outlined in this letter to verify your current residential address, you could face delays when attempting to vote or even be removed from the voter registration list after a period of time. Having your information updated in our system will ensure a smoother voting experience.


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
