

DON'T FORGET YOUR PHOTO ID WHEN YOU GO TO VOTE

Virginia law now requires all voters to show
an acceptable photo ID at the polls

What's an acceptable photo ID?

Acceptable forms of photo ID include Virginia DMV-issued photo IDs and driver's licenses; U.S. Passports; employer-issued photo IDs; student photo IDs from a school, college, or university located in Virginia; photo ID cards issued by the United States, the Commonwealth of Virginia, or local Virginia government; and Virginia Voter Photo ID cards.

What if I don't have an acceptable photo ID?

You can get a Voter Photo ID card from any voter registration office for FREE, including on Election Day. If you show up to vote on Election Day and don't have a photo ID, don't worry! You can still vote a provisional ballot. You must provide a copy of an acceptable photo ID or get a temporary Voter Photo ID at your voter registration office by noon on the Friday after the election for your vote to count.
