
June 18, 2024 Primary US House of Representatives Party Candidate Ballot Access Quick Look One Pager

- A. File the following with the Virginia Department of Elections (ELECT) between 1/2/24 and 5 pm 4/4/24.
 - 1. Certificate of Candidate Qualification*

- *May be postmarked by 4/4/24 deadline if mailed registered or certified USPS mail. Be prepared to provide a copy of the receipt on 4/4/24.
- 2. Primary Filing Fee: \$3,480
 - *Make check/money order payable to Virginia Department of Elections.
- B. File the following documents with the **Political Party Congressional District Chairman** between **noon 3/18/24** and **5 pm** 4/4/24.*
 - *All of these documents must be filed at the same time.
 - 1. Declaration of Candidacy

- 2. Receipt for Primary Filing Fee
- 3. Petitions of Qualified Voters*

- *You may begin collecting signatures on 1/2/24.
- *Signature Requirement: 1,000 signatures from qualified voters in the congressional district where you are seeking election
