WHEREAS, a vacancy has occurred in the Senate of Virginia from the 10th Senate District, composed of all of Amelia, Appomattox, Buckingham, Cumberland, Fluvanna, Goochland and Powhatan Counties and part of Hanover, Henrico, Louisa and Prince Edward Counties, occasioned by the resignation of The Honorable John J. McGuire, III.

NOW THEREFORE, in the name of the Commonwealth, pursuant to § 24.2-216 of the *Code of Virginia*, you are hereby required to cause an election to be held in this district on January 7, 2025, for a member of the Senate of Virginia to fill the vacancy. The last day for filing as a candidate for such office in said election shall be December 16, 2024, at 5:00 p.m.
