TO THE SECRETARIES OF ELECTORAL BOARDS AND GENERAL REGISTRARS OF THE CITY OF VIRGINIA BEACH AND THE CITY OF NORFOLK:

WHEREAS, a vacancy has occurred in the Senate of Virginia from the Seventh Senate District, composed of part of the City of Virginia Beach and part of the City of Norfolk, occasioned by the resignation of The Honorable Jennifer A. Kiggans.

NOW THEREFORE, in the name of the Commonwealth, pursuant to § 24.2-216 of the *Code of Virginia*, you are hereby required to cause an election to be held in this district on January 10, 2023, for a member of the Senate of Virginia to fill the vacancy. The last day for filing as a candidate for such office in said election shall be Monday, November 21, 2022, at 5:00 p.m.
