DECISION ON APPEAL

In the matter of the campaign finance penalty appeal
by Kathy Coffee for School Board (CC-23-00429)
January 14, 2026

FACTS

The above-named petitioner had campaign finance reports due from 2017 to 2025. Petitioner submitted a final report, for the April 17, 2023 report, on December 10, 2025. A \$62,100 civil penalty for failure to file the required reports was issued by Lunenburg County General Registrar on December 3, 2025.

Pursuant to § 24.2-953.6 of the Code of Virginia (the Code), petitioner submitted a *Petition to Appeal Campaign Finance Penalty* to the State Board of Elections (SBE) on December 10, 2025. Petitioner sought relief in the form of “forgiveness of all assessed penalty”. Petitioner’s basis for appeal was that there was an administrative error in the assessment of the penalty. Petitioner stated that good cause existed to provide relief due to the initial lack of notice of penalties, and the candidate/treasurer is deceased.

DECISION

The SBE heard the appeal on January 14, 2026. Pursuant to § 24.2-953.6 of the Code, the SBE determined that the petitioner demonstrated good cause to justify relief as requested.

RATIONALE

In finding that the petitioner demonstrated good cause, the SBE noted the lack of communication between the General Registrar’s office and the petitioner regarding notice of penalties. The SBE also noted that the candidate/treasurer is deceased.
