**FINAL ORDER**


Came this day the petitioner on a Petition for Recount in the election of Sheriff for the County of Prince George, Virginia, held on November 2, 2021. In accordance with Virginia Code Section 24.2-801, et sequentes, and the Court's order of procedure to which the parties agreed, the Court, after settling all matters pertaining to the recount of the vote as raised by the parties and having ruled unanimously that the only two votes in contest were votes for the respondent, does hereby certify to the State Board of Elections and the electoral board for the County of Prince George as follows:

- 1) the total number of votes for Paul W. Burroughs is 4,992, and
- 2) the total number of votes for R. W. "Buck" Vargo is 5,001, and
- 3) THEREFORE, R. W. "Buck" Vargo is declared elected to the office of Sheriff for the County of Prince George, Virginia.


The costs of the recount shall be assessed pursuant to Virginia Code Section 24.2-802.3.

It is SO ORDERED.




