Came this day the petitioner on a Petition for Recount in the election of Delegate to the Virginia House of Delegates for the 82nd District, held on November 7th, 2023.


In accordance with Virginia Code Section 24.2-801, and the Court's Order of procedure to which the parties agreed, the Court, after settling all matters pertaining to the recount of the votes as raised by the parties and having ruled unanimously, does hereby certify to the State Board of Elections and the electoral boards for the City of Petersburg and the Counties of Dinwiddie, Prince George and Surry as follows:

1. The total number of votes for Kimberly Pope Adams is 14,236; and
2. The total number of votes for Kim A. Taylor is 14,289; and
3. THEREFORE, Kim A. Taylor is declared elected to the office of delegate to the Virginia House of Delegates for the 82nd District.
4. No costs of the recount shall be assessed pursuant to Virginia Code Section 24.2-802.3.

The clerk shall forward a copy of this Order to the parties and remove this cause from the active docket. Endorsements are dispensed with pursuant to Rule 1:13 of the Supreme Court of Virginia.

It is so ORDERED.


